

Note SAAF 17: Kowalski's house was ½ kilometer from Michelin and bordered on a nearby forest. When the plane piloted by Jack van Eyssen crashed Kowalski's was first on the scene and managed to rescue Jack van Eyssen and four other members of the crew. Three crew members died in the crash. Kowalski erected a wooden cross at the spot, then another memorial and finally a concrete structure. Every year flowers were laid at the memorial.
